JANITIANA KELLY:

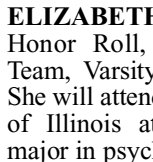

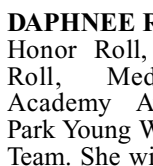
VALENTINA KWARTANG

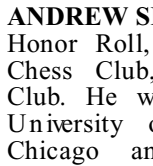
DAPHNEE RENE:

Honor Roll, Math Award, Chess Club, Multi-Media Club. He will attend the University of Illinois at Chicago and major in Computer Science.

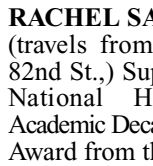


AARON WHITE:

The four seniors who were not Rogers Park residents are:



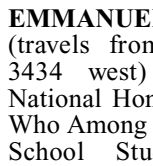
OLEHSNADR GRECHKO:
